# Ogg Clues from Christine Ogg (not proven ancestors)

- 1752 John Ogg & wife came to America
- 1793 John Ogg & Mildred Gassett were married July 24, 1793, Richmond County, Georgia
- c1804-08 John Thomas Ogg born in Georgia
- 1814, May 2 James Churchill appointed guardian of Thomas & Amelia Ogg, minor orphans of John Ogg, deceased
- Nov 7, 1814 Division of estate of John Ogg, deceased, ordered at request of James Dinsley in right of his wife Hester Ann Dinsley, formerly Hester Ann Ogg
- May 15, 1831 (John) Thomas Ogg & Eliza Suggs were married, Richmond County, Georgia

Dec 3, 1835 (John) Thomas Ogg & Martha Fulcher were married in Richmond County, Georgia

1840 John (Thomas) Ogg & wife Martha & family appear on Dimes County Census

1860 (John) Thomas Ogg & family appear again on Census for Dimes County

Nov 7, 1814 Division of estate of John Ogg, deceased, ordered at request of James Dinsley in right of his wife Hester Ann Dinsley, formerly Hester Ann Ogg

May 15, 1831 (John) Thomas Ogg & Eliza Suggs were married, Richmond County, Georgia
