

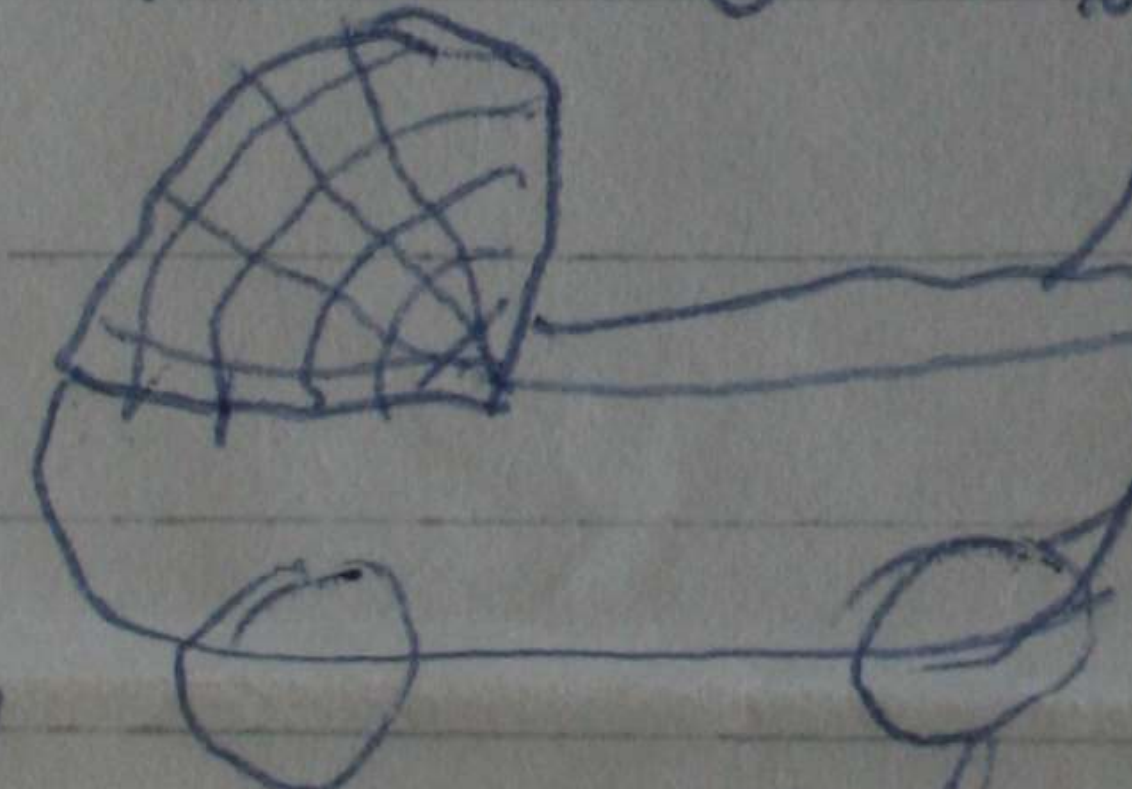
Last letter from Auntie
