The Registers of Births, Deaths and Marriages pertaining to every Registration District in Scotland are kept in duplicate for each year; and, after being examined and compared, one of the duplicates is retained by the Local Registrar, and the other is transmitted to the Registrar-General in Edinburgh. Every person is entitled to search the alphabetical Indexes of the duplicate Registers in the custody of the Registrar, upon the days and during the hours of business fixed by law, where no special regulation has been made by him upon the subject, at all reasonable hours on any lawful day, on payment of a fee of 2s. for a General, and 1s. for a Particular Search, and to have an Extract of any Entry in the said Indexes for a further sum of 2s. 1d., including Stamp Duty. In the case of a Particular Search, the applicant must indicate a particular name or entry; while in the case of a General Search, he does not require to specify the object of such search. Every Extract of any Entry in the Register Books kept under the provisions of the Registration Acts (17 & 18 Vict. c. 80, 18 Vict. c. 29, and 23 & 24 Vict. c. 85) duly authenticated and signed by the Registrar, is admissible as evidence in all parts of His Majesty's Kingdom of Scotland.
