PASSENGERS' CONTRACT TICKET.

-A Contract Ticket in this form must be given to every Passenger engaging a passage from the United Kingdom to any place out of Europe, and not being within the Mediterranean Sea.
-The Victualling Scale for the voyage must be printed in the body of the Ticket.
-All the Blanks must be correctly filled in, and the Ticket must be legibly signed with the Christian names and surname and address in full of the party issuing the same.
-The day of the month on which the Ship is to sail must be inserted in words and not in figures.
-When once issued, this Ticket must not be withdrawn from the Passenger, nor any alteration, addition, or erasure made in it.

NOTICES TO PASSENGERS.
