

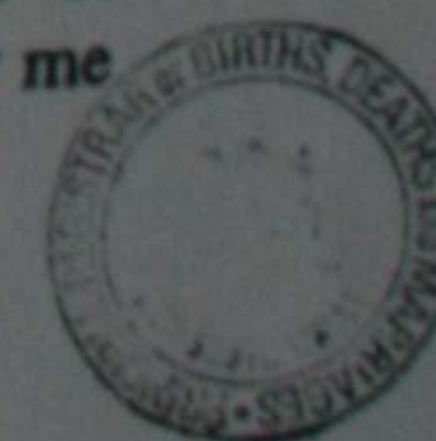

SINCLAIR

Birth                      Birth of Hugh Sinclair circa 1810 in Aberfeldy  
Aberfeldy lies partly in the parish of Dull and partly in the parish of Logierait.

The records of both these parishes were searched as follows:

OPR Dull 346/5 searched 1805-1815

Noted:

2nd March 1810

Ewen son to Dun. Sinclair and Isabel Maclaren in Tulliecuil baptised.

Note: Ewen and Hugh are synonomous.

OPR Logierait 376/2 searched 1805-1815

No Sinclair families recording the baptisms of their children in Logierait parish registers at this time.

Marriage                      Marriage of Hugh Sinclair and Agnes Spiers

The Old Parish Registers of Dull (346/6) and Logierait (376/4) were searched 1827-36, but without success.

Census                      1841 Census for Dull 346/6

No entry found for Hugh (Ewan) Sinclair living in Easter Aberfeldy at this time.

1841 Census for Logierait 376/11

No entry for Hugh Sinclair living in Wester Aberfeldy at this time.

Unfortunately, the relevance of the entry for the baptism of Ewen Sinclair could not be proved.

OPR Dull 346/4

16th Feb. 1793

No entries found for any Sinclairs in Tullicuil at  
this time.

No entry of possible relevance found anywhere in Dull.



Birth

Birth of Duncan Sinclair

The Old Parish Registers of Dull (346/3) were searched 1763-1776.

No entry of possible relevance was found - though there were a number of Sinclair families recording the baptisms of their children in the parish at this time.

In particular the following entry was noted for possible interest:

3 Aug. 1774

Christian daughter to Don'd Sinclair and Elspeth McLaren in Tullicuil was baptised.

No other children were born to this family in Dull over the years searched and it seemed possible that these could be the parents of Duncan, who had moved to Dull from another parish after his birth.

A search was therefore made of the OPRs of the surrounding parishes of Fortingall (355A/1), Kenmore (360/3) and Logierait (376/2), covering the years 1763-1776.

The registers for Fortingall were much spoiled and not all the entries could be read.

No entry of possible relevance was found in Fortingall or Logierait - though the following entry was found in Kenmore:

22 June 1776

Duncan son to Duncan Sinclair and Milred Campbell in Tomphluir was baptised.

Unfortunately the relevance of this entry cannot be proved.

20 Feb. 1831

Gregor MacGregor and Christian Sinclair both in this parish gave up their names to be proclaimed in order to marriage.

Death

Death of Christian Sinclair or McGregor

Crieff 342/87

Christian McGregor died 23rd December 1857 at Comrie St., Crieff. Aged 58.

Daughter of Duncan Sinclair, farmer deceased and Isabella McLaren deceased.

Cause: paralysis 8 hours.

Buried - Churchyard Monzie.

Informant: Gregor McGregor her husband

Death of Gregor McGregor

Comrie 341/23

Gregor McGregor, quarrier, widower of Christina Sinclair, died 15th December 1881 at Comrie.

Aged 83.

Son of Donald McGregor, soldier, Athole Highlanders, deceased and Elizabeth Drummond (maiden surname) deceased.

Cause: natural decay.

Informant: Daniel McGregor, his son, 18 Seamore St., Glasgow.

Birth of Gregor McGregor

OPR Monzie 382/1

29th Sept. 1799

Gregory McGregor, son of Donald McGregor in Wester Fendoch and Betty Drummond his spouse.

Also -

23rd May 1802

James son of Donald McGregor couper in Wester Fendoch and Elizabeth Drummond his spouse

21st June 1803

Peter son of Donald McGregor, couper, Wester Fendoch, and Elizabeth Drummond his spouse.

No other children recorded to this family in Monzie 1803-1812.

Marriage

Marriage of Donald McGregor and Elizabeth Drummond

OPR Monzie 382/1

19th January 1799

Donald McGregor and Betty Drummond both in this parish.

Births

The Old Parish Registers of Monzie (382/1) were then searched from 1763-1776 for the birth of Donald McGregor and also for the birth of Duncan Sinclair since it was thought the two families may have lived near each other.

No entry of possible relevance was found in either case in the baptismal registers of this parish.
